

This is an Opt Out Request for Human Growth and Development and Health Classes

Purpose: Request the removal of my child/children from all Human Growth and Development and Health instruction.

To: The Building Principal

For My child or children: _____

As provided by the Iowa Code 279.50 and 256.11 sec. 6, I am removing my child/children from ALL Human Growth and Development and sexual health instruction. I do not want him/her to be instructed in contraception/ birth control, “responsible” reproductive “health”, sexually transmitted diseases, including AIDS, or abortion, the morning after pill or the HPV shot. Do not provide him/her with any material that has anything to do with “sexual health.” No matter how well-intentioned or what you believe is good for him/her, do not do it.

In addition, I do not want any *counseling* individually or in small groups to assist her/him in accepting so called “wise choices” from alternatives presented them in society. I do not agree with the popular version of this type of wisdom that is being presented in sexuality training.

Do not involve my child in the “Peer Helper Program” or the “Health Program” or any new program that is sanctioned by the state to encourage “responsible choices.”

Do not involve my child in “Personal and Family Living.”

These programs appear to have good intentions; however, they inevitably contradict our personal and religious beliefs and corrupt the sexuality of the children. In 1986, the Human Growth and Development was signed into law by Governor Branstad with the option for parents to remove their children. This is a clear indication that it is not biological “health” information, but rather “sexual” information which has proven to be in most cases over the years to be anti-life, anti-marriage, promoting sexual perversion.

If your school has infused the curriculum into health or science, making it virtually impossible to opt out, you will have to find a way to remove my child or children before the instruction begins. The law has made the provision in the Iowa Code and it is therefore the **burden of the school** to make sure that my child is **not** included in these programs.
