Iowa City Planned Parenthood aborts more later-term babies than other Planned Parenthoods in Iowa and Midwest

PP sees Iowa women as cash cows or guinea pigs

IOWA CITY—Did you know Planned Parenthood is aborting babies in Iowa City further along than in Des Moines, Bettendorf and Sioux City?

Not all Planned Parenthoods offer the same abortions. Iowa City's Planned Parenthood advertises abortions up to 21 weeks, 6 days (1 day short of calling it "22"). That's further along than Planned Parenthood in Des Moines, which advertises abortions up to 19 weeks, 6 days.

Iowa City is one of Planned Parenthood's four surgical abortion centers in Iowa (they call them "in-clinic" abortions.) Planned Parenthood also has 14 locations doing abortions by webcam, where the doctor is not even in the

building to examine the woman, before she is given the RU-486 abortion pill cocktail, then sent home to abort her child. There are also five Planned Parenthoods in Iowa that are "Abortion Referral" sites.

Why have abortions up to 22 weeks in Iowa City? It could be because they have emergency back-up at the University of Iowa Hospitals. The further along an abortion is, the more likely the complications. It might be that they have abortionists in Iowa City willing to abort that far along—**Continued on Page 6...**

"Abortion Referral" first on list of services at new Planned Parenthood Cold and Flu Clinic

DES MOINES—Planned Parenthood left out some key details when they announced to the media on March 1 their new location at 818-5th Avenue in downtown Des Moines.

First, Planned Parenthood told the media that the new location is for "treatment for colds and the flu, sore throats and ear-aches" (*Associated Press* 3/2/13). Planned Parenthood spokesperson Shelby Cloke said abortions will not be performed there. But on Planned Parenthood's website, first on its list of services for the new so-called "My Health Express" center is, "Abortion Referral."

If you click on the link for "Service Details" for the new location, the first

thing it tells you is, "Abortion services by appointment only." Then there is information on the morning-after pill and how to get other forms of birth control. Planned Parenthood's website says nothing about "Treatment for colds and the flu, sore throats and ear-aches" for the new 818-5th Avenue location.

Planned Parenthood's rebranding of the new location as, "My Health Express," is fooling no one. As much as Planned Parenthood tries to disguise themselves as "family practice," their number one money makers are abortion and contraception.

Last year, Planned Parenthood of

the Heartland aborted 5,828 babies more than adoptions they helped facilitate.

Obama speaks at Planned Parenthood Gala without mentioning the A-word

WASHINGTON D.C.—You would have thought it was a speech before the American Cancer Society.

When Obama became the first sitting president to address America's largest abortion retailer, he forgot to mention something: *abortion*.

In addressing the Planned Parenthood fundraising gala on April 26, 2013, at the Marriott Wardman Park Hotel in Washington DC, President Obama talked a good game about cancer screenings. (Did someone not tell him after the Presidential Debates that Planned Parenthood still does not do mammograms?)

Our Commander in Chief mentioned mammograms, cancer screenings, breast cancer and cervical cancer *SEVEN TIMES* in his 12 minute speech. He did use the abortion industry's buzz phrase "right to choose" several times, but not as much as cancer.

Speaking to the largest abortion machine in the country, he did not say the word "abortion" once.

President Obama did have this anecdote about a woman from Chicago named Courtney, "...who has a disease that can leave women infertile. So in college, she turned to Planned Parenthood for access to affordable contraceptive care to

death after her abortion at Planned Parenthood last September at 16 weeks?" That would be Planned Parenthood on Michigan Avenue.

Obama's Mamas: The White House's leading ladies who push Planned Parenthood's abortion agenda



WASHINGTON D.C.—Ronald Reagan had Dutch's Dollies. Barack Obama has **Obama's Mamas**. To understand how steeped in **Planned Parenthood** the Obama White House is, you need to know the women standing by their man.

When introducing Obama at the Planned Parenthood

Gala on April 26, CEO Cecile Richards gave special thanks to two advisors to the President for their "extraordinary work" with Planned Parenthood: **Valerie Jarrett** and **Tina Tchen**.

Valerie Jarrett: Called the "single most influential person in the Obama White

House" by the *New York Times*, Jarrett, a Senior Advisor and one of the Obama's closest personal friends, is said to be the one who pushed for forcing Catholic institutions to cover contraceptives as part of Obamacare. She has been a featured speaker at past

Who will be buying your daughter Plan B?

Better get to know your daughter's boyfriend...and his parents.

DES MOINES—A few years back, a mother in Iowa contacted Iowa Right to Life, distraught that her 16 year-old daughter was taken to Planned Parenthood for an abortion without her knowledge. Who took her to Planned Parenthood? The mother of her daughter's boyfriend.

The boyfriend's mother signed the parental notification paperwork with her own name. Planned Parenthood personnel did not check any IDs to verify who the woman was or if she was even related to the girl. Why? Because they don't have to.

Under Iowa's current Parental Notification Law, abortion providers do not have to verify that the person signing as the "parent" actually is the parent. Anyone can bring a minor in for an abortion and claim to be a girl's parent – her boyfriend's parent, a teacher or coach from school, or a statutory rapist she met on the Internet. That loophole in the law has never been closed. (*IRTL News*, Fall 2009)

The point of the story, however, is that 15 year-old girls may not be the ones making the Plan B over-the-counter purchase. It will be boyfriends, who will hold it out to the girl and say, "If you love me, you will take this." Or it will be a boyfriend's mother or father who will say to her, "Your parents never have to know."

The scarier scenario will be the boyfriend who purchases Plan B and slips it into his girlfriend's food, without her knowledge. This has already been done with RU-486 in several cases around the U.S.

Plan B: How it works...

Plan B also known as "Emergency Contraception" is a specific brand, which contains the hormone progestin levonorgestrel, a high dosage of the same ingredient found in many birth control pills, without the estrogen.



Like the birth control pill, Plan B does not always stop conception from occurring, but hardens the lining of the uterus, so a conceived child will not implant in the uterine wall and essentially be aborted.

Different from RU-486:

While Plan B may cause an abortion, it is different from RU-486 abortion pills — which are really a cocktail of abortion pills that kill the baby in the womb, then later (sometimes days, sometimes weeks) expel the baby.

Side Effects

Local college students have been telling Iowa Right to Life that young women on their campus are having sex every weekend and taking Plan B after each time.

Typical side effects of Plan B, according to *WebMD.com*, include: nausea, abdominal pain, fatigue, headache, menstrual changes, dizziness, breast tenderness, vomiting, diarrhea.

But Plan B is not meant to be taken repeatedly. An MD and hormone specialist told *Fox*

News there are many more serious documented side effects that come from overusing Plan B. Those include: "significant weight gain, depression, ovarian cyst enlargement, gall bladder disease, high blood pressure, and increased risk of ectopic pregnancy," according to Dr. Jennifer Landa of *BodyLogicMD*. (*Fox News*, April 5, 2013.)

Plan B's own website warns about ectopic pregnancy: "If your patient experiences severe abdominal pain, she may have an ectopic pregnancy and should seek immediate medical attention." (www.planbonestep.com)

Planned Parenthood's website, downplays side effects and withholds serious side effects: "There have been no reports of serious complications among the millions of women who have used the morning-after pill. Side effects are uncommon, and usually stop within a day or two." (www.Plannedparenthood.com/health-topics/emergency-contraception-morning-after-pill-4363.asp)

But Planned Parenthood must be getting the same information that IRTL is about the college women using Plan B every time they have sex, because later on the same page, Planned Parenthood's website says, "Emergency contraception should not be used as a form of ongoing birth control because there are other forms of birth control that are a lot more effective and less expensive."

How easily bloviating Bruce Braley blows his stack

DES MOINES—The most surprising thing about the race for **Senator Tom Harkin's** seat is not that the Republicans don't have anyone to run against **Bruce Braley**. *It's that the Democrats don't have anyone to run against Bruce Braley.*

Braley is unparalleled for his narcissistic windbaggy. Take this gem from his final debate with



challenger Ben Lange last year in Dubuque, where Braley talked of visiting flood-ravaged Waterloo:

"...we went out into the light during the dark and this young thirteen year old kid looked up at me and said, 'Are you Bruce Braley?' And I said, 'Yes.' And he said, 'Are you my congressman?' And I said, 'Yes.' And he went and he got his friends because he was so excited to know that I was in his neighborhood helping him out."

First, how many 13 year-olds have a congressman anywhere on their radar, let alone, bubbling with excitement to introduce their friends to him? But going from the dark to the light was really jumping the shark.

And Braley's bloviating in this debate only got bigger:

*"I think voters should ask themselves why **Newsweek** magazine reported that I took on the leadership in my party to change the way we pay for Medicare which is the biggest challenge we face going forward."*

This says a lot about why *Newsweek* ceased printing in the U.S. at the end of 2012.

Braley is a notorious hothead. In

that debate, Lange, the pink-cheeked boy from Quasqueton, got Braley swearing mad by questioning his claim to have read the entire Obamacare bill before voting for it:

Braley: *He obviously didn't read the bill because it was my legislation that is changing the way we pay for Medicare by giving incentives to value outcomes, by helping hospitals by quality purchasing and by finally moving to a system that rewards quality outcomes and moves away from fee for services...*

Lange: *I know you mentioned reading the bill. You're telling us that you read 2,700 pages?*

Braley: *You're damn right I read the bill. I took it to every - I took it to every one of my 17 townhall meetings, Ben, and if you had come to them you would have seen that.*

Lange: *2,700 pages in the middle of the night?*

Braley: *I had every page highlighted, I had my handwritten notes in the margin and I had tabs there. I take my job very seriously, Ben.*



Lange: *2,700 pages in the middle of the night, you read it before they passed it? Your leadership -*

Braley: *That's another big lie, James.*

Lange: *Your leadership said they had to pass the bill to see what was in it.*

Braley: *Dean -- Dean, this is the most discussed, most debated, most analyzed bill --*

Lange: *There was a tax in it two*



years later.

Braley: *-- in the history of this country and Ben knows it. 17 townhall meetings, ten hearings --*

Lange: *Your mom is listening to this, Congressman, tell the truth.*

Braley: *Oh please, don't lecture me on family values, Ben. My mom knows who I am, she knows what I stand for and she is voting for me.*

Lange: *Congressman, you're sitting up on this stage -*

Braley: *Yes, I am. I am sitting up on this stage trying to keep my patience.*

Lange: *You read 2,700 pages in the middle of the night before it was passed?*

Braley: *It wasn't the middle of the night.*

Moderator Dean Borg: *We are - gentlemen -*

Braley: *You don't understand how legislation is passed obviously.*

Lange: *The speaker of your party said she had to pass it to see what was in it.*

Braley: *Oh come on, Ben. Come on.*

Borg: *Wait - we're losing - gentlemen*

Braley: *I read the bill. I read the bill.*

Lange: *You knew there was a tax in it.*

Braley: *I read the bill.*

Braley is so on the ropes he is

Gosnell vs. Planned Parenthood's Meadows

"I've never heard of this anywhere else. There aren't Gosnells operating all over the country. This case is as unusual as it is unspeakable."

—Eric Ferrero, VP of Communications for Planned Parenthood Federation of America, speaking to USA Today about Dr. Kermit Gosnell's gruesome abortion methods. (*Des Moines Register*, April 22, 2013)

DES MOINES—Planned Parenthood's official line on **Dr. Kermit Gosnell**, on trial for cutting the spinal cords of babies born alive during abortions in his house of horrors abortion clinic in Philadelphia, has been: *GOLLY! We're just as shocked as everyone else.*

But the people of Planned Parenthood need look no farther than their own fold. Planned Parenthood's top abortionist in Iowa is so similar to Gosnell, it's scary. Below is a side-by-side comparison of Gosnell grisly methods vs. Planned Parenthood of the Heartland's Medical Director, **Dr. Jill Meadows**, also a late-term abortionist.

Meadows' work—including twisting and tearing apart live babies in the womb and crushing their skulls—is documented in the 2007 Supreme Court Case **Carhart vs. Gonzalez**. Back then, she was known as Dr. Jill Vibhakar.

Dr. Kermit Gosnell Philadelphia Abortionist Under Fire



Gosnell had a simple solution for the unwanted babies he delivered: he killed them. He didn't call it that. He called it "ensuring fetal demise." The way he ensured fetal demise was by sticking scissors into the back of the baby's neck and cutting the spinal cord. He called that "snipping."

(Grand Jury Report in the case against Kermit Gosnell, Page 4)



Dr. Jill Meadows Planned Parenthood's Top Abortionist in Iowa

"Before Dr. Vibhakar (Meadows) begins a second-trimester D & E, the fetus is likely alive, as documented by an ultrasound performed either a day or a few weeks before the procedure. Dr. Vibhakar does not know when

fetal demise occurs during her procedures, nor is there any clinical significance to when demise occurs in her opinion." (Carhart vs. Gonzalez, Tr. 346, Test. Dr. Vibhakar)

She said that he (Gosnell) would "crack" the neck after the head was out – when only the baby's torso was still inside the mother – and then suction the brain matter out. (Grand Jury Report in the case against Kermit Gosnell, Page 109)

"Dr. Vibhakar (Meadows) has had two cases at 18 or 19 and 21 weeks where the fetus has delivered intact up to the head, after which she disarticulated the body from the head, used forceps to compress the fetal head, and extracted the head." (Carhart vs. Gonzalez, Tr. 341-42 and 381-83, Test. Dr. Vibhakar.)

He (Gosnell) tried to inject a drug called digoxin into the fetus's heart while it was in the womb. This was supposed to cause fetal demise in utero. But because Gosnell was not skillful enough to successfully administer digoxin, late-term babies continued to be born alive, and he continued to kill them by slitting their necks. (Grand Jury Report in the case against Kermit Gosnell, Page 111)

Dr. Vibhakar (Meadows) does not induce fetal demise prior to performing abortions with interuterine or intrafetal injections of digoxin or KCl because "[i]t's not deemed necessary..." (Carhart vs. Gonzalez, Tr. 347-49, Test. Dr. Vibhakar)

When asked how many times Ashley had observed babies being delivered that were moving or breathing or crying and the doctor cut the neck, she answered: "Most of the second tris (trimester) that were over 20 weeks." She said this happened probably dozens of times, maybe more. She described at least 10 babies as big enough to buy clothes for, to dress, and to take care of. (Grand Jury Report in the case against Kermit Gosnell, Page 114)

When Dr. Vibhakar (Meadows) begins a D&E, she cannot predict whether it will come out largely intact or in pieces. Dr. Vibhakar testified that 100% of her second trimester D&E procedures involve fetal dismemberment. (Carhart vs. Gonzalez, Tr. 362, Test. Dr. Vibhakar)

Second, Planned Parenthood never mentioned to the media they will be in the same building as the Young Women's Resource Center, which serves girls as young as 10. This is more evidence that Planned Parenthood is targeting children—not for colds and flu, but for its core business of birth control and abortion.

The new Planned Parenthood location on 5th Avenue is strategic—across from Vets Auditorium and a block away from Wells Fargo Arena, where they will try to snare young people coming in for state basketball and wrestling tournaments and other events.

This "bait and switch" is typical of Planned Parenthood.

When the Susan Knapp Planned Parenthood opened in the Drake University neighborhood back in 2007, Planned Parenthood's CEO Jill June crowed about how they would be offering prenatal care, "We're pleased to be able to expand our prenatal programs to families in this part of Des Moines. This added dimension demonstrates Planned Parenthood's strong commitment to increasing health care delivery and supporting healthy families," said June.

Strong commitment? After the media cameras stopped rolling, the Susan Knapp Planned Parenthood quietly switched to abortions by webcam. Prenatal care is not listed among their services. (See *IRTL News*, October 2011: "Prepare for Bait and Switch with New Planned Parenthoods in Iowa.")

Make no mistake. Planned Parenthood is about abortion—not health care.

although that doesn't make sense that nearby Bettendorf, probably served by the same abortionist, would be limited to 18 weeks.

It could be for competitive advantage—Emma Goldman in Iowa City advertises abortions up to "19 weeks and 6 days" and Planned Parenthood might be trying to out-abort them for the profits.

In the Midwest, only St. Louis and Kansas City Planned Parenthoods have thresholds comparable to Iowa City:

The only other Planned Parenthood we found so far that does abortions further along than 22 weeks is in **New York City**, which advertises them at **24 weeks**. This clinic, is ironically called the "**Margaret Sanger Clinic**" for Planned Parenthood's founder.

What this demonstrates again is that Planned Parenthood sees women in Iowa as either cash cows or guinea pigs. Maybe both.

Who Is Viable?

Babies have a good chance at survival outside the womb at 24 weeks. Medical advances are increasing earlier survival rates.

Pictured here is **James Elgin Gill**, of Ottawa, Canada, one of the earliest born premature babies to survive. In 1987, he was born at just 21 weeks, 5 days (within Planned Parenthood's abortion target) He will be 26 this year.

calling out for rescue to the moderators Dean Borg and the *Cedar Rapids Gazette's* James Lynch, who had given him cover throughout the debate.

This exchange also shows Braley's condescending nature: "...*He obviously didn't read the bill... You don't understand how legislation is passed obviously... Don't lecture me... I am sitting up on this stage trying to keep my patience...*"

Notable is Braley's line, "...*don't lecture me on family values.*" Lange never said, "family values," but clearly that's a sensitive issue with Braley.



Bruce Braley, running for Harkin's seat, has a 100% voting score with Planned Parenthood and NARAL.

That's because when Braley boasts about "*reaching across the aisle*" and "*working with the other side,*" ... he doesn't mean on Pro-Life issues.

Braley has a 100% voting score from Planned Parenthood and the National Abortion Rights Action League (NARAL.).

Some Iowans are looking at this election as a foregone conclusion. But clearly, it's an opportunity. In 2010, Ben Lange came within two percentage points of beating Braley. He's the most beatable candidate since Christie Vilsack. Braley even uses her "*liar, liar pants on fire*" line. (Oh, those clever Democrats!)

When there is a challenger for Braley, ask yourself, "How mad am I at Obama-care?" Then help register a few voters. Ask, "How mad am I at Obama's Mamas robbing Peter to pay Planned Parenthood? (Story on Page 2.) Then knock on a few doors. Ask, "How much do I not want to see this guy's face for six years?" Then make some phone calls.

Planned Parenthood events as recently as last September. During the PP Gala speech, Jarrett tweeted: *"Watching President Obama speak at Planned Parenthood. Our partner in improving health for all women."*



Tina Tchen: Officially Assistant to President Obama and Chief of Staff to Michelle Obama, Tchen was a former Vice President of the National Organization for Women (NOW) and featured speaker at Planned Parenthood's Conference on Health Care Reform, back in 2009. Tchen is also Executive Director of the White House Council on Women and Girls, a new government agency Obama created by executive order in March 2009 to advise him on issues related to women. The Chair



of the new Agency? Valerie Jarrett.

Catherine "Cathy" Russell: Just recently appointed to another new position created by Obama: Ambassador at Large for Global Women's Issues at the United Nations. Planned Parenthood's CEO Cecile Richards has already released a statement congratulating her, stating they *"look forward to working together"* with Russell, who was formerly Chief of Staff to Jill Biden. If confirmed, Russell will replace Melanne Vermeer, who National Right to Life has described as *"Abortion Ambassador to the World."* Vermeer was former Chief of Staff to Hillary Clinton when she was First Lady.



Susan Rice: You may remember the U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations and almost Secretary of State with the deadly bungling of Benghazi. But did you know Rice was



endorsed by Planned Parenthood, NOW and Emily's List? The Family Research Council said, *"As a member of both the Clinton and Obama administrations, Rice has been a shameless advocate for exporting abortion-on-demand—even to countries with moral objections."*

(Washington Update, FRC11/29/12).

Peggy Kerry: Also involved in the global abortion push at the U.N. is the sister of Secretary of State John Kerry'. (Yes, the, "Why the long face?" joke works with her, too.) A former consultant to Planned Parenthood, Kerry is a long-time liaison for American non-government organizations (NGOs) at the U.N.



What all these appointments show is that Obama's abortion ambitions are not domestic. They're global.

The next question: what was Courtney's "disease that can leave women infertile" Obama mentioned? If it were a sexually transmitted disease, which Planned Parenthood is always claiming to test and treat, it might be Chlamydia or Bacterial Vaginosis. And how did Planned Parenthood treat her? With affordable contraceptives, according to Obama. Typical Planned Parenthood: throw condoms at it and see what sticks. *Care. No Matter What.*

Don't let such scenes discourage you, let them motivate you. There are so many ways to get involved in the life movement to make a difference:

Help distribute literature to your churches, schools, neighbors and friends, volunteer with us to set up a Pro-Life booth at your county fair and much more.

Instead of warning women about the dangers, Planned Parenthood turns it into a cheap come-on to sign up women for their profitable "C-mail" program, so Planned Parenthood can buy the contraceptives for \$2.98 and bill Medicaid for \$26.32 for the same contraceptives.)
